Warm or cold, the sailing season starts this month with our first race of the Rosemary Lucas Cup Series on March 14th. I encourage everyone to come out and race your boat or crew with another club member (members are always looking for crew). It is very laid back, great fun and gives you a chance to hone your sailing skills. Our race committee chairman, Butch Nolan, is organizing several additional events this year including around the bay races and sunfish regattas! A social will also be held on March 14th, so make a day of it and come out and enjoy the club.

Repair work on the bayside bulkhead has begun. Our plan is to have this work done gradually when the contractor has time between jobs. This approach will spread the work out over a longer period of

time which also spreads the expense out making it more manageable for the club. As was stated in the February issue of the Pointer, the cost of repairs that are needed, like the bulkhead repair, exceed the club's ability to fund them based solely on dues. The CYC Board has considered many options to raise funds to address the most immediate repair needs. Such options included borrowing more money, fund raising activities, increasing dues, increasing slip rents and others. As a result, the CYC Board has authorized the following actions: 1) Increased slip rentals, and 2) Imposed a \$120 per vear maintenance fee for the next two years. (The maintenance fee will be included in your 2nd quarter statement and is payable either as a onetime payment or \$30 per quarter. All of these funds will be earmarked for use to make needed repairs at the club. If you have any questions or suggestions, please contact me or any

other board member.

Remember the club is available for use by members and their accompanied guests. Members are also welcome to use our facilities for parties, family events, etc., provided you comply with the rules established for such use. If vou are interested in using the facilities for such an event, please check with me or one of the other board members so we can determine if there is anything else planned at the same time.

These activities and events happen because members like you get involved and make them happen. Please consider volunteering your time or special talents to help the club.
