Sunfish Racing Program by Butch Nolan

Mark your calendars! The first annual *Sunfish Sunsplash* race will take place this year on **April 20th**. The following two will occur **May 18th**, **and June 15th**. The CYC will have seven sunfish available for use by skippers the only thing you need to show up with is your stopwatch and life jacket!

The schedule is as follows; **10:00 AM-** Skippers meeting at the clubhouse. **11:00 AM-** First gun. **3:00 PM-** latest possible start for final race. The course will be set within a half mile of the yacht club. The course itself will consist of a windward and leeward leg, with the start and finish lines both between the committee boat and starting buoy. All starts will be three minutes, and the races will be short (we hope to sail at least seven). No race will start after 3:00p.m. There will be water available between starts on the chase boat/committee boat. If you are new to sailing, don't be afraid to come out and give it a shot! Sunfish are very simple, very safe, and very easily handled boats. The race committee will have a chase boat to assist sailors, as well as to bring people in and out to the course when needed. For fairness, skippers will be cycled from boat to boat so no one uses the


