Sunfish Sailing Camps: 2024

We will offer both adult and kid's Sunfish sailing classes this summer. <u>The adult class is open to</u> <u>CYC members and is scheduled for June 8-9, 2024</u>. Registration for the adult class is limited to eight students. We've received good reviews on the class from the students. Weather permitting, it is definitely possible to learn how to sail in one weekend.

<u>The kid's sailing "camp" is set for July 12-14, 2024</u>. We typically start at 9:00 am and run until about 3:00 pm on Friday and Saturday, and 9:00 am until approximately 1:00 pm on Sunday. Some of the instruction is on-shore. Weather plays a part in the on-water instruction: ideally, we're looking for sunny days and moderate wind (7 mph - 12 mph), but we'll do our best to work with what Mother Nature serves up. Lunch will be provided. The CYC will send participants / parents information explaining what to expect, what to bring and the basics of sailing.

There is no registration fee for CYC members' children and/or grandchildren to attend the kid's sailing camp. Participants in the kid's camp should be age 11 or older. There is a nominal fee for non-member children. Registration is limited so act soon and sign up.

Registration ends when the classes fill up or on May 7, 2024.

<u>Volunteers Needed</u>: Of course, we always need help with the camp/classes, particularly on-water instructors. If you sailed a Sunfish, Sailfish, Laser or similar craft as a youth, it really is like "riding a bike" and as much fun as you remembered. We could use your help. If you are interested in volunteering, but think you might need a "refresher course" we can do that too. I'm happy to make arrangements to meet and sail with any potential Sunfish on-water instructor volunteers to provide a "refresher course" opportunity. I'm available late-March through May 20. Contact me and we can arrange to sail a Sunfish and get some practice in. **Chase boats, ramp assistants, lunch & refreshments support, able-bodied persons always welcome.**
