Racing News by Bill Whitehead

The first two races in the fall Daily Iberian Cup series have been completed. Race 1 on September 9 featured five competitors, moderate winds at the start and a three-way photo finish. While there was a "tie" in absolute finish time, when the handicapping formula that adjusts for differences among the sailboats was applied, Butch & Chris Leger were declared the winner, with Mac & Brent Boulet second, and John & Julie Conner third. Dan Snow and Al Lillev finished in fourth and fifth place, respectively.

The Race Committee didn't need a computer to determine the winner of the Daily Iberian Cup Race 2 on September 23. John & Julie Conner finished first in absolute time (16 minutes) and adjusted time (10) minutes. Mac and Brent Boutlet finished second and Ray Schwartz finished third.

Club members took out two Sunfish sailboats on September 23 as part of our "experiment" to provide more sailing access and opportunity on scheduled race days. The weather was perfect for the Sunfish (sunny and 6-8 mph wind). The boats were out for about two hours and it was a really nice day to sail.

A Round-the-Bay Race (#5, PHRF Class) is also scheduled for Saturday, October 7. The Skipper's meeting will be held at 10:00 am.

Daily Iberian Cup series races are scheduled for October 14 (#3) and October 28 (#4).

We will again have Sunfish sailboats available for recreational use by CYC members on October 14, weather permitting (**we don't have a "chase boat", so wind must be below 12 mph). Members reserving a CYC Sunfish should have participated in the Sunfish Sailing Camp or have small sailboat experience.

If you are interested in reserving a Sunfish on October 14, <u>you must contact me in</u> advance so I can get everything ready. I'll begin moving boats to the loading ramp area after the Daily Iberian race Skipper's meeting at 10:00 am and the Sunfish are due back within an hour of the completion of the Daily Iberian race (time varies but typically midafternoon.
