Racing News by Bill Whitehead

John Conner won the Rosemary Lucas Cup race #3 held on April 8, in a close race with six sailboats competing over a course that measured 10.75 miles. Ed Duhe finished just two minutes behind with Mac & Brent Boulet finishing 3rd. Race # 4 in the series held on April 22 was also a close one with the first two finishers only two minutes apart on elapsed time. This time Ed Duhe finished first, leading on actual and corrected time, with John Conner coming in 2nd. Al Lilley finished 3rd, with a

total of five boats competing.

The 1st Round-the-Bay race scheduled for April 29 had to be cancelled due to a severe weather front that blew through with observed winds from the southeast at a consistent 25 mph. The wind event continued through the day and gusts at the club were over 40 mph Saturday night into Sunday morning.

The CYC Spring Regatta will be held this coming Saturday, May 6, 2017, and will

be combined with the Round-the-Bay race #1.

The Rosemary Lucas Race #5 will be held on May 13 and the Round-the-Bay race #2 on May 20. We have a makeup date available for the Rosemary Lucas Cup Series on May 27 and the race committee will make a decision on using same following race #5.

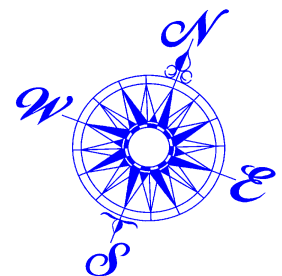
Sailing is one of the few sports/skills that kids can enjoy way into adulthood and its more fun than video games. Parental caution: sailing is addictive, in a good way.
