As everyone knows Hurricane Season started June 1st,

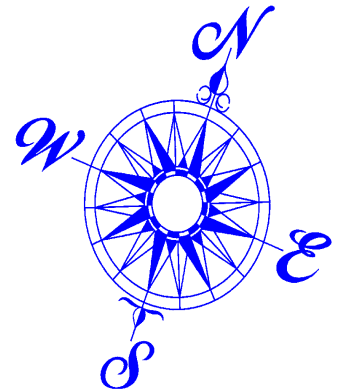
